FISHING CLUB

The Fishing and Aquatic Research Club meets Fridays from 7am-8am to fish at Discovery Lake on the school campus. We will be meeting at additional times as we begin marking and tracking largemouth bass, monitoring water conditions, and considering environmental affects on the lake. The Aquatic Research Club amplifies the STEM engagement opportunity in an exciting way. *The YMCA has provided us the opportunity for lake access for Fishing Club. Use of the water is ours during school by permission from the YMCA. The lake is catch and release and fishing is not open to the public.*



GREENHOUSE PROJECT/AG CLUB

The Greenhouse Project, an extension of AG Club, will launch very soon! A group of interested leaders will be meeting this week on location to review what is available and what some options would be before we engage interested students. 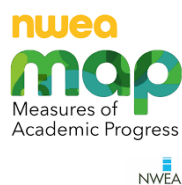
LUHI COFFEE CO.

SCHOOL SIGNS & FUTURE ENROLLMENT

New yard signs are in production and should be ready in about a week. The signs are similar but change "Opening Soon" to "Enrolling Now". You will be able to get yours on campus at Lutheran High. Enrollment is open throughout the year. A student/family who is not finding success at their current school can transfer any time during the school year.

In answer to some questions you might get when you talk about Lutheran High, **"YES"** we are fully accredited through WASC and the Accredited School Association. **"YES"** students receive an accredited transcript. **"YES"** we are a missional Lutheran high school that welcomes the community. **"YES"** we are an Acellus Community School and partner with Acellus Academy. **"YES"** we have real teachers and they teach about 2/3 of the day with 1/3 being delivered by personalized on-line curriculum. **"YES"** our schedules and approach are personalized for each student as they grow through the grades. **"YES"** we offer AP and Dual Credit opportunities, CTE courses and internships. **"YES"** our year and school day are both a little shorter than other school and still we will accomplish as much and more! Mostly, **"YES"** you can play sports at your local public school. And **"YES"** we integrate the faith into the entire school day. Students, families and education are a gift from God!



NWEA TESTING

Lutheran High-Fremont and our partner Lutheran high schools in Nebraska complete NWEA testing each fall and spring. For LuHi-Fremont, Northwest Evaluation Association (NWEA) testing will happen next week Tuesday and Thursday. English Language Arts & Math tests will be given. The test is a great way to measure individual student progress over time.

4TH FRIDAY

This Friday (3rd Friday this month because of the Mayor's schedule) will take us off campus for a visit with Mayor Joey Spellerberg.
